THE JIMMIE HALE MISSION

Providing services to the poor and destitute

Founded in 1944, we have four different ministries that demonstrate the love of Christ to those in need.

The New Men's Complex is the oldest of the Jimmie Hale Mission's facilities. It is located at the corner of 35th Street and 2nd Avenue North. The Men's Complex houses the men's shelter, meal-times for our men's ministry, a recovery program, men's clothing distribution and nightly chapel programs.

Royal Pines Center: Opened in 1995, Royal Pines is a sixteen-week, in-residence substance abuse recovery center. Royal Pines uses a biblical approach to overcoming addiction. Located on 73 acres in the Bangor area of southern Blount County and accommodating 26 men, Royal Pines provides opportunity for men to seriously address the issues of addiction and homelessness. Jessie's Place. Jessie's Place is a shelter for homeless and hurting women and children seeking shelter while preparing to reach self-sufficiency.
